On February 26, 2010, Mr. Kevin Delancey an Asbestos Inspector for the State of Michigan, Accreditation Number A39427, Expiration Date 2/17/2011, conducted an asbestos building inspection of Benton Harbor Charter School, building one, located at 455 Riverview Drive, Benton Harbor, Michigan 49022

The attached Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) 3 year re-inspection as required by 40 CFR 763.85 (b) is submitted for signature and filing.

The asbestos containing materials identified in the Re-Inspection Report was collected from the January 5, 2004 Re-Inspection Report as prepared by Asbestos Environmental Consulting and Training of Michigan.

The following response actions are required:

1. The previous re-inspection report states that the building is asbestos free. No further action is required at this time. This site visit confirms that no other response action is required. Future asbestos re-inspections are no longer required.


