RE: CIPA Compliance, Benton Harbor Charter School Academy (BHCSA)

BHCSA is deploying iBoss Web Filtering a hybrid web filter with on-premise filtering hardware as well as a cloud based system. Additionally BHCSA computer workstations are secured by user authentication with Microsoft Active Directory service running on Windows 2016 synced with G Suite authentication thus allowing access to the network by authorized persons only and recognizing the various levels of permissions between student user and staff user.

BHCSA filtering activity **includes but is not limited to:**

- (a) access by minors to inappropriate content on the Internet;
- (b) the safety and security of minors when using electronic mail, chat rooms and other forms of direct electronic communications;
- (c) unauthorized access, including so-called "hacking," and other unlawful activities by minors online;
- (d) unauthorized disclosure, use, and dissemination of personal information regarding minors;
- (e) measures designed to restrict minors' access to material harmful to minors.
