

RE: CIPA Compliance, Benton Harbor Charter School Academy (BHCSA)

BHCSA is deploying iBoss Web Filtering a hybrid web filter with on-premise filtering hardware as well as a cloud based system. Additionally BHCSA computer workstations are secured by user authentication with Microsoft Active Directory service running on Windows 2016 synced with G Suite authentication thus allowing access to the network by authorized persons only and recognizing the various levels of permissions between student user and staff user.

BHCSA filtering activity includes but is not limited to:

- (a) access by minors to inappropriate content on the Internet;
- (b) the safety and security of minors when using electronic mail, chat rooms and other forms of direct electronic communications:
- (c) unauthorized access, including so-called "hacking," and other unlawful activities by minors online;
- (d) unauthorized disclosure, use, and dissemination of personal information regarding minors:
- (e) measures designed to restrict minors' access to material harmful to minors.
