

**RESOLUTION FOR BUDGET AMENDMENT BY THE BOARD OF
EDUCATION FOR CARSON CITY-CRYSTAL AREA SCHOOLS**

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall amend the general appropriations of Carson City-Crystal Area Schools General Fund for the 2017-18 fiscal year. A resolution to make appropriations; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of all income received by Carson City-Crystal Area Schools General Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total revenues and unappropriated fund balance estimated to be available for appropriations in the General Fund of the Carson City-Crystal Area Schools for the 2017-18 fiscal year are amended as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no Board of Education member or employee of the school district shall expend any funds or obligate the expenditure of any funds except pursuant to appropriations made by the Board of Education and in keeping with the budgetary policy statement hitherto adopted by the Board. Changes in the amount appropriated by the Board shall require approval by the Board.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent is hereby charged with general supervision of the execution of the budget adopted by the Board and shall hold the department heads responsible for performance of their responsibilities within the amounts appropriated by the Board of Education and in keeping with the budgetary policy statement hitherto adopted by the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for purposes of meeting emergency needs of the school district, transfers of appropriations may be made upon the written authorization of the Superintendent. When the Superintendent makes a transfer of appropriations as permitted by this resolution, such transfer shall be presented to the Board of Education for consideration and adoption by the Board of Education.


This amendment is to take effect December 11, 2017.
