For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been assigned one of these labels.

Through the school improvement process, our school has identified achievement gaps and is implementing a variety of strategies to increase student achievement. There is a continued focus on students with disabilities and students most at risk. Farwell Elementary teachers are becoming trained in LETRS, the Science of Reading, Math Workshops, and Into Math. School-wide reform strategies, such as Intervention Groups, and Differentiated Instruction will continue to be utilized by teachers.

<u>PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL</u>: There is only one building in the district that serves grades K-3, therefore, all district pupils in this grade span are assigned to Farwell Elementary School.

STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN: The Farwell Elementary School Improvement Team meets regularly throughout the school year. The purpose of the team is to develop, review, and evaluate goals, objectives, and strategies for the School Improvement Plan. The School Improvement Team facilitates the continuous collection and analysis of academic assessment data to guide instruction, evaluate programs, and work towards student achievement goals.

<u>BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCHOOL:</u> Farwell Elementary School is a traditional public school, serving students in kindergarten through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. During the 2022-23 school year, there were 329 students. In 2023-24, there were 312 students.

For the 2023-24 school year, 88% (275) of Farwell Elementary School students were represented during the Fall 2023 Student/Parent/Teacher Conferences.
