What is it?

- Grant dollars for four focus areas:
 - Address unfinished learning
 - Get students to grade level academic standards
 - Provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers, or
 - Help high school students prepare for postsecondary college
- Funding:
 - \$303.18 per non proficient student: Math or ELA M-Step (3-7th grade), PSAT (8th grade), SAT (11th Grade)
 - Could be more depending on how many districts apply and qualify

BC Implementation:

- **HS**
 - Enhance the current tutoring program. Hire more highly qualified staff to conduct tutoring sessions, offering more accessible times, offering transportation.
 - Creation of a tutoring center/ online classes. Available during the entire school day.
 - Provide transportation for: CTE program tours, job shadowing
 - Credit recovery: summer transportation - Helping families with tuition
- **MS**
 - Enhance the current tutoring program. Hire more highly qualified staff to conduct tutoring sessions, offering more accessible times, and transportation.

- Provide target ELA/ Math intervention for grades 6-8. This includes providing professional development and needed intervention resources.

How can students access?

1- Students will be invited to access tutoring programs based on performance/ grades/ or skill needs.
