We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2024-25 educational progress for E. E. Knight Elementary School. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as 'HAS NOT BEEN GIVEN ONE OF THESE LABELS.'

In most areas, our data indicates minimal to no growth in ELA between the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 school years. We continue to examine our benchmark data to develop appropriate interventions and remediation strategies for our students across all tiers of instruction. We are utilizing small group reading interventions, including programs such as Phonics for Reading and REWARDS. We have implemented the reading series Bookworms with fidelity for our Tier 1 instruction.
