Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2024-25 educational progress for Ovid-Elsie Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2025-2026 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as a 'HAS NOT BEEN GIVEN ONE OF THESE LABELS'.

All core academic areas including Math, English Language Arts, Social Studies, and Science have been reviewing curriculum. These departments have been working to align standards, with curriculum and daily lessons. Additionally these departments are reviewing assessments for standards alignment, depth of knowledge questioning and assessment practices. Teachers are researching curriculum expectations and best practices to ensure student growth. The school is implementing new PBIS initiatives and in the third year of implementing Tier 2 behavioral supports.
