The meeting was called to order at 8:00 pm by President, Daniel Lasceski.

Due to the fact the Board is unable to place a qualified teacher to educate the students of Church School, Daniel Lasceski made a motion, supported by Cindy Prill, to authorize the Board take the next steps to secure an agreement with another local school (beginning with Bad Axe Public Schools, second choice North Huron Schools) to educate the students of Church school for the 2024-2025 school year. This motion also includes the Board will take all steps necessary to notify the parents of the enrolled students of Church school. Motion carried unanimously.

Dolores Gorkowski will email Tracy Potter regarding how to proceed with the applications received for schools of choice now that Church school is unable to educate students for the 2024-2025 school year.

Purchases for the 2024-2025 will be handled on an as needed basis.
