Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

The district will pivot to fully remote learning for the next month.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Pre-Kindergarten:

Remote learning with walk in services and support available.

Elementary (Grades K - 5):

Remote learning with walk in services and support available.

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):

Remote learning with walk in services and support available.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):

Remote learning with walk in services and support available.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

All students are learning remotely but have the option for support.

Document Public Comments:

One public comment was made supporting the shift to remote instruction. The speaker did indicate that she would like to see the district consider full face to face for students when the period of remote instruction ends.
