Reconfirmation Meeting for January

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
The district will continue to have preK and special education program students attend full face to face five days per week. Elementary students will continue in a hybrid and 6th-12th grade students will resume hybrid learning on February 1st. Alternative education will transition from remote instruction to full face to face instruction on February 1st. Kindergarten through fifth grade students will resume full face to face instruction as of March 1st.
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Pre-Kindergarten: Students will continue in face to face instruction following their typical schedule.
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Students will continue in the hybrid and virtual instructional models until March 1st. As of March 1st, students not in the virtual program will resume face to face instruction five days per week.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): All middle school students will remain in remote learning until February 1st. Students not in the virtual program will transition to the hybrid learning model on February 1st.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): All high school students will remain in remote learning until February 1st. Students not in the virtual program will transition to the hybrid learning model on February 1st.
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

Special education program students are attending full face to face instruction five days per week. Alternative education high school students will resume full face to face instruction on February 1st.

Document Public Comments:

There were 24 comments made during public comment urging the board to consider bringing students back and comments for the Board to consider waiting to bring students back until it's safer.
