Reconfirmation Meeting on February 5, 2021

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
The district will continue to have preK and special education program students attend full face to face five days per week. All other students K-12 will continue in a hybrid model until March 1st.
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Pre-Kindergarten: Students will continue in face to face instruction following their typical schedule.
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Students will continue in the hybrid and virtual instructional models until March 1st. As of March 1st, students not in the virtual program will resume face to face instruction five days per week.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Students will continue in the hybrid and virtual instructional models until March 1st. As of March 1st, students not in the virtual program will resume face to face instruction five days per week.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Students will continue in the hybrid and virtual instructional models until March 1st. As of March 1st, students not in the virtual program will resume face to face instruction five days per week.
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
Special education program students and alternative education high school students

are attending full face to face instruction five days per week.

Document Public Comments:

There were 13 comments made during public comment urging the board to consider bringing students back as quickly as possible, requesting an option to remain virtual should the district bring students back fully F2F and expressing frustration with the current hybrid model.

Review Weekly 2-Way Interaction Rates was not conducted as this was a special board meeting not the regularly scheduled monthly meeting.
