Reconfirmation Meeting for March

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

The district will continue to have all students attend full face to face five days per week and offer a fully virtual program for those families who wish their students to learn remotely.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Pre-Kindergarten:

Students will continue in face to face instruction.

Elementary (Grades K - 5):

Students will continue in face to face instruction five days per week.

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):

Students will continue in face to face instruction five days per week.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):

Students will continue in face to face instruction five days per week.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

All special populations students are able to attend face to face five days per week at all levels

Document Public Comments:

There was only one comment made during public comment. The PHEA President spoke thanking the district for the well run vaccine clinics, expressing concern over the number of students who are quarantined or are choosing to self quarantine and asking what the metric is that would trigger a building closure.
