**Reconfirmation Meeting for April**

<b>Reconfirm instructional delivery method:</b>
The district will continue to have all students learn remotely and offer a fully virtual program for those families who had already selected that they wished their students to learn remotely.
<b>Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:</b>
Pre-Kindergarten: Remote learning with support available in Learning Labs.
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Remote learning with support available in Learning Labs.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Remote learning with support available in Learning Labs.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Remote learning with support available in Learning Labs.
<b>Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:</b>
All special populations students will continue in remote learning and receive individualized services remotely and in Learning Labs.
<b>Document Public Comments:</b> There were 8 public comments - six from teachers, one from a student and one from a parent. Multiple speakers requested the Board of Education consider safety and consistency for staff and students. Three speakers

asked the Board of Education to consider a hybrid model, so quarantines are reduced and students have consistent face to face access to their teachers. Two speakers expressed frustration with the lack of consistency for their students and their students desire to be in school with their teachers.
