Reconfirmation Meeting for April

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
The district will have all students attend full face to face five days per week starting on May 3rd and offer a fully virtual program for those families who wish their students to learn remotely.
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Pre-Kindergarten:
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Students will have face to face instruction five days per week starting May 3rd.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Students will have face to face instruction five days per week starting May 3rd.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Students will have face to face instruction five days per week starting May 3rd.
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
All special populations students are able to attend face to face five days per week at all levels starting May 3rd.
Document Public Comments: There were 8 speakers during public comment. Two speakers were teachers advocating that the Board of Education consider safety and consistency for staff and students in their decision. Three speakers were students

advocating to return students to school and allow after school activities to resume. Three speakers were parents advocating that students return to school face to face for the remainder of the school year.

Review Weekly 2-Way Interaction Rates: Two way interactions were not reviewed on 4/28 since they were reviewed the week prior on 4/19.
