**Reconfirmation Meeting for May**

<b>Reconfirm instructional delivery method:</b>
The district will have all students attend full face to face five days per week and offer a fully virtual program for those families who wish their students to learn remotely.
<b>Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:</b>
Pre-Kindergarten: Students will continue with face to face instruction.
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Students will continue with face to face instruction.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Students will continue with face to face instruction.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Students will continue with face to face instruction.
<b>Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:</b>
All special populations students are able to continue attending face to face five days per week at all levels.
<b>Document Public Comments:</b> There were two speakers during public comment. Both were teachers asking the Board of Education to recognize the amount of time that teachers are working outside of their school day to support quarantined and absent students.
