Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

The district will have all students attend full face to face five days per week and offer a fully virtual program for those families who wish their students to learn remotely.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Pre-Kindergarten:

Students will continue with face to face instruction in the fall of 2021.

Elementary (Grades K - 5):

Students will continue with face to face instruction in the fall of 2021.

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):

Students will continue with face to face instruction in the fall of 2021.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):

Students will continue with face to face instruction in the fall of 2021.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

All special populations students are able to continue attending face to face five days per week at all levels.
