K-5 High Dosage Tutoring Plan

Schedule

- All sessions are held after school
- 3-4 days per week
- Reading and math are the primary focus
- Sessions are 4 weeks for math and 4 weeks for reading each trimester

Students

- Students are invited based on their assessment results
- NWEA
- Fountas and Pinnell
- Other Local Assessments, as needed

Instructional Resources

- Reading: Literacy Footprints Intervention Partner and Corrective Reading
- Math: DELTA Math Lessons and Tiered Intervention Lessons on individual standard skills

Secondary High Dosage Tutoring/Credit Recovery Plan

<i>Schedule</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All sessions are held after school• Offered 4 days per week• Reading and math are the primary focus• Students are invited based on classroom grades and NWEA scores. They are also allowed to drop in if support is needed.
<i>Instructional Resources</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tiered Intervention Lessons on individual standard skills for math and literacy.
<i>Credit Recovery</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students have the opportunity to retake courses they didn't earn credit in and they can't retake in their traditional school schedule hours.
