Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
Face to face Grades GSRP-12; offering virtual to those who choose online learning
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Reese Great Start Readiness Program: Started October 5, 2020 Face to face; offering virtual to those families who choose it
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Face to face; offering virtual to those families who choose online learning
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Face to face; offering virtual to those families who choose online learning
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Face to face; offering virtual to those families who choose online learning
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
No, Reese is offering face to face. In-person assistance offered to special education remote/virtual MS/HS and special education remote/virtual elementary students.
