Statement: It is a district-wide goal to establish and implement Multi-tiered Systems of Support and Extended Learning Opportunities in order to provided targeted instruction and improve student performance for ALL students and close performance gaps for marginalized subgroups by 2025. Avondale will increase counseling and social work services at all levels, including alternative education at DCI. Additionally, the district will invest in adaptive instructional technology at all tiers to support reading and math skills necessary for growth and proficiency. MTSS will be supported through MTSS Coordinators at both the elementary adn secondary levels.

Avondale Diplomas and Careers Institute will establish success coaches, a student retention speacialist, and behavior specialist to support student engagement and participation in coursework to increase 4-year graduation rates, as well as communicate the importance of participation in state required testing. Additionally, DCI will offer incentives to assessment participation.

Summary: EdTrust defines expanded learning time (ELT) as programs or strategies implemented to increase the amount of instruction and learning students experience. ELT strategies include afterschool, summer, and in-school programs. The evidence suggests that extended learning time programs, including extended school day (ESD), extended school year (ESY), and expanded learning opportunities (ELO) programs that provide academic services during out-of-school time hours, can be effective in improving a range of educational outcomes for students. Findings also suggest that extended learning time programs may be more advantageous for low-income, low-performing, ethnic minority or otherwise disadvantaged students.
