Request Option for Parents and Legal Guardians for 23g MI Kids Back-on-Track

The **MI Kids Back-on-Track** grant funds (MCL 388.1623g) (23g) will support programs provided before school, during school, after school, or during the summer. These funds are designed to address unfinished learning, get students to grade-level academic standards, provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers, or help high school students prepare for postsecondary education.

23g requires districts to provide a process that allows parents, legal guardians, and students to request additional assistance through the MI Kids Back-on-Track program.

*If you believe your child could benefit from additional assistance with their learning as outlined in our posted plan, please contact their building principal directly.

The building principal will work with you and a member of the teaching and learning team to:

- Schedule a meeting to discuss your concerns, understand your child's needs, and review their educational data
- Help determine what type of supports may be provided
- Form a written plan of support
