## Public Act 144 of 2022 – Section 98c – Learning Loss



## What It Is

- \$52,056,000 statewide
- Part of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund (GEER)
- Meant to help schools reduce learning loss through innovative practice
- Minimum amount a district can expect to receive is \$36.75 = \$42,078
  - This is if every eligible school and district applies so it probably would be more
  - Will get actual amount once application window closes at end of November
- Grant cycle is October 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 June 30<sup>th</sup> 2023 must be spent this year

## How We Intend To Spend The Money

- Paper subscription for High school and possibly middle school (depending on final allocation)
  - 24/7 access to live online tutor / homework support for all subjects
  - Integrates with google classroom
  - Can be used as an in-class resource/intervention
- If funding is greater than cost of Paper subscription
  - Social Studies / Science materials
  - Offset current tutoring expenses
