2023-2025 23G MI Kids Back on Track Grant Plan

In Plymouth-Canton Community Schools, we support all of our students as they strive to meet their current grade level and course outcomes. We are also continuing to support our students who have additional needs or learning gaps. Our 23G grant-funded MI Kids Back on Track plan provides additional resources and programs aligned with our Multi-Tiered Systems of Supports (MTSS) district-wide by assisting students who need additional time to achieve at grade level through reteaching, additional time outside of the regular day, or summer programs.

This grant will provide funds to support students through Tier II and III interventions. Eligible targeted students will be offered the following supports to help them achieve at grade level through summer learning opportunities.

Small Group Targeted Instruction, Grades 9-12 (Credit Recovery)

- The program runs over 31 days in the summer from June 30 - July 31, 2025. Sessions take place from 7:25 am - 1:30 pm.
- Breakfast and lunch are provided.
- Transportation is available.
- Sessions are taught by highly qualified teaching and support staff
- Curriculum resources aligned with the Michigan Academic Standards

Summer Academy K-8

- This program runs for four weeks from June 30 - July 31, 2025.
- Sessions take place Monday through Thursday from 8:00 to 11:30 am.
- Breakfast and bagged lunch are provided
- Transportation is provided.
- Sessions are taught by highly qualified teaching and support staff
- Curriculum resources aligned with the Michigan Academic Standards include:
 - Teacher-designed science-based units (K-5 ELA & Math)
 - Teacher-designed literacy units based on novels (6-8 ELA)
 - Teacher designed math units (6-8 Math)

English Learner (EL) Summer Jump Start

- This program runs for four weeks from June 30 - July 31, 2025.
- Sessions take place Monday through Thursday from 8:30 am - 11:30 am
- Breakfast and bagged lunch are provided
- Transportation is provided.
- Sessions are taught by highly qualified teaching and support staff
- Curriculum resources include:

- Teacher-designed units to support oral language development
- STEM Sports
- An Accelerated Kids partnership program to support literacy and math instruction using computer science and robotics

Greatness Camp

- This program runs June 24 - July 24
- Sessions take place Monday - Thursday 9:00 am - 12:00 pm
- Breakfast and bagged lunch
- Sessions are facilitated by highly qualified teaching and support staff
- Curriculum resources include:
 - Personal Development
 - Study Skills
 - Soft Skills
 - High School Transition(s)
 - Becoming A Scholar, Reading, Writing, and Mathematics
