

98c Learning Loss Plan Lakeshore Public Schools

What is 98c?

- Part of Public Act 144 of 2022 (MCL 388.1698c)
- Part of Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) and part of the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Plan (ESSER II)
- These funds are recent funds not originally distributed by the State of Michigan

Plan Requirements

- Must address learning loss
 - Must be presented to the Board of Education
 - Must be posted to the LEA website
- Must report on progress by August, 2023

Lakeshore Public Schools Plan:

- We will use these funds to expand and enhance evidence based practices that we already support in Tier I, II and III instruction. This includes maintaining certified staff, as well as specialized staff to carry out instruction and/or remove barriers from at-risk students so that instruction is optimized during the school day and during the summer.
- Program progress will be measured by tracking student data from M-STEP and NWEA data to see growth patterns.
- We will comply with all state and federal reporting guidelines.
