Effective July 1, 2023, Quincy Community Schools agrees to the following regarding the 2022-2025 Master Agreement between Quincy Community Schools and Local 2597, Michigan AFSCME Council 25, AFL-CIO

1. The AFSCME Master Agreement 2022-2025 Appendix A, Section 1, Regular Run rates will be updated to reflect an increase as indicated below:

> Probationary: \$19.02 \$21.02 Step 1: \$20.31 \$22.31 Step 2: \$21.58 \$23.58

- 2. The AFSCME Master Agreement 2022-2025 Appendix A, Section 1, New drivers will receive a onetime bonus of \$1000 after the completion of the 2023/2024 school year to be paid out on the second pay period in June of 2024. This bonus shall be prorated depending on the date of hire.
- 3. The AFSCME Master Agreement 2022-2025 Appendix A, Section 1, All current regular route drivers will receive a retention bonus of \$1000 after the completion of the 2023/2024 school year to be paid out on the second pay period of June of 2024.
- 4. The AFSCME Master Agreement 2022-2025 Appendix A, Section 1, any current full-time bus driver that refers a successful candidate for an open full-time driving position will receive a \$500 referral bonus. The candidate must be hired by the district and driving a full-time route for Quincy Schools, after the training period, for 3 months in order for a referral bonus to be earned. Documentation of the referral must be in place at the district by the initial hire date of the candidate.
