Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
Face to face, streamed, and self-paced online
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Pre-Kindergarten: N/A
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Face to face, streamed, self-paced online
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Hybrid alternating day schedule from January 04, 2021 through January 22, 20201, then face to face, streamed, self-paced online
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Hybrid alternating day schedule from January 04, 2021 through January 22, 20201, then face to face, streamed, self-paced online
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
Rates are similar for all populations, however full time face to face instruction for these groups will be determined on a case by case basis while the 6-12 hybrid alternating day schedule is active.
Document Public Comments:
January 18, 2020: public comment solicited. Two staff members spoke to encourage

face to face learning, especially for grades 6-8. Multiple parents made public comment. Most encouraged face to face learning for all grades, with some expressing that grades 9-12 were better able to handle the hybrid schedule than younger students.
