Process:

1. Provide Supporting Information: Depending on the nature of the request, parents may be required to provide additional documentation or information to support their request. This could include academic records, medical documentation, or any other relevant materials.
2. Review Process: The submitted request and supporting information are then reviewed by the program administrators. Eligibility for additional assistance is based on the provided details and program guidelines.
3. Approval or Denial: After review, the request is either approved or denied. If approved, the type and extent of assistance are determined based on the individual needs of the student.
4. Implementation: Once approved, the assistance is implemented according to the agreed-upon plan. This may involve additional tutoring, counseling, accommodations, or other forms of support as deemed necessary.
5. Monitoring and Follow-Up: Throughout the assistance period, the progress of the student is monitored closely. Adjustments may be made to the assistance plan as needed based on the student's progress and changing needs.
6. Closure or Renewal: Once the assistance has achieved its objectives or the specified time period has elapsed, the program administrators will either close the assistance plan or initiate a renewal process if further assistance is required.
