Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

Students will begin the year with face-to-face instruction while wearing masks in the classrooms, common areas, and on buses. Students in quarantine will be taught remotely via Google Classroom for all of their classes, as well as any students opting for the online option. All students will be attending live synchronous instruction. This schedule attends to the health and safety of students and staff members while maximizing instructional delivery and learning.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Grades PK - 12

Students will begin the year with face-to-face instruction while wearing masks in the classrooms, common areas, and on buses. Students in quarantine will be taught remotely via Google Classroom for all of their classes, as well as any students opting for the online option. All students will be attending live synchronous instruction. This schedule attends to the health and safety of students and staff members while maximizing instructional delivery and learning.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

Mid Peninsula has established structures for general and special education teachers and/or providers to collaborate and communicate regarding student performance and student needs on IEP goals and objectives with special consideration regarding assistive technology and accessibility.

Mid Peninsula ensures a continuation of services for students receiving speech and language, occupational therapy, physical therapy, or social work services within their IEP. The district also ensures a method for the continuation of evaluation for students suspected of having a disability as well as those requiring re-evaluation.

Mid Peninsula will follow the special education guidance set forth by the State of Michigan Department of Education during the pandemic.
