Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2019-20 educational progress for the Bois Blanc Pines School District. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2019-20 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not identified for improvement from the State of Michigan.

Bois Blanc Pines School District is a one-room schoolhouse on located on Bois Blanc Island. The school provides education to the K-8 students on the island. Major challenges have been staffing and enrollment. During the 2019-2020 school year, the school closed as there were not any students enrolled. The Board has worked to re-open the school with new staff and now has five students enrolled.


State law requires that we also report additional information:

- 1) PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO SCHOOL – Bois Blanc Pines School is the only school on the island. Registered students are all in one classroom.
- 2) STATUS OF SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN – The Board, administration and teacher are currently working in a strategic planning process to update previous plans. A facilitator from the EUPISD is assisting in this process.

- 3) SPECIALIZED SCHOOLS – Bois Blanc Pines School provides general education and special education to students in grades K-8.
- 4) THE CORE CURRICULUM: A copy of the core curriculum can be found on the EUPISD website. Our teacher is involved in training with ISD personnel in curriculum and alignment.
- 5) AGGREGATE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT RESULTS: Due to the very small number of students assessed, data in the AER is limited. Due to the small classroom numbers, Bois Blanc Pines School District does not disaggregate data by gender, race, or socio-economic status.
- 6) NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES: At the most recent conferences, 100% (5 students) of students were represented at conferences.

Bois Blanc Pines School District is making great strides in improving in the educational environment of the school. Student needs are prioritized, and communication has greatly improved. I commend the Board, staff and community for their work and dedication to their small school.
