We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Bois Blanc Pines School District. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2018-19. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2017-18. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2016-17. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these designations.

Bois Blanc Pines School District is a one-room schoolhouse located on Bois Blanc Island. The school provides education to the K-8 students on the island. Major challenges have been staffing and enrollment. During the 2019-2020 school year, the school closed as there were not any students enrolled. The Board worked to re-open the school with new staff in 2020-2021. There are currently three students enrolled and one teacher employed.


State law requires that we also report additional information.

- 1) PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO SCHOOL – Bois Blanc Pines School is the only school on the island. Registered students are all in one classroom.
- 2) STATUS OF SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN – The Board, administration and teacher are currently working in a strategic planning process via the Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process. A facilitator from the EUPISD is assisting in this process.
- 3) SPECIALIZED SCHOOLS – Bois Blanc Pines School provides general education and special education to students in grades K-8.
- 4) THE CORE CURRICULUM: A copy of the core curriculum can be found on the EUPISD website. Our teacher is involved in training with EUPISD personnel in curriculum and alignment.
- 5) AGGREGATE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT RESULTS: Due to the very small number of students assessed, data in the AER is limited. Due to the small classroom numbers, Bois Blanc Pines School District does not disaggregate data by gender, race, or socio-economic status.
- 6) NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES: At the most recent conferences, 100% of students were represented at conferences.

Given the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, our students have been fortunate to remain in face-to-face instruction for the majority of the last school year. The staff, students, and Board of Education should be commended for their efforts to maintain a safe and healthy environment for teaching and learning.
