Dear JKL Parents/Guardians,

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020-2021, school districts were required to develop an Extended (COVID-19) Continuity of Learning (ECOL) Plans. During the 2020-2021 school year, the ECOL Plan was approved by the Board of Education and then reconfirmed each month thereafter.

Since then, school boards are no longer required to approve or reconfirm the ECOL Plans. School districts are now required to review (and update, as necessary) the Continuity of Learning Plan every six months. Additionally, school districts were required to establish student achievement or growth goals by September 15, 2023 and report progress at public board meetings by the first board meeting in February 2024 and again at the last board meeting in June 2023.

To remain compliant with these reporting requirements, Northern Michigan University established student growth goals (98b) and will be updating the Board of Education on February 6, 2024. The growth goals data may be reviewed <u>HERE</u>. We are making good gains, but there is still work to be done.

A student growth percentile (SGP) is a percentile ranking from 1 to 99 which explains a student's academic progress compared to his/her academic peers.

SGPs are grouped into three levels:

Low Growth: SGPs less than 40

Typical Growth: SPGs between 41 and 65 High Growth: SGPs greater than 65
