Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Three Oaks Public School Academy. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

Three Oaks Public School Academy has an achievement gap in both math and reading when compared with the State of Michigan average percent of students proficient according to the MSTEP test. In order to address the concerns with student achievement, the school has worked to improve initial instruction through professional development, coaching and collaboration. Areas of focus were student engagement strategies, early literacy training, positive behavior supports, curriculum development, and implementation of trauma informed practices. We have worked to improve the multi-tiered system of supports to intervene as needed to improve student learning by reaching students in their areas of academic need. Our school has also worked hard to implement restorative justice practices which have made significant improvements in behavior and school culture. Our team has also been working to improve initial instruction through deepening planning and intellectual preparation for Tier 1 instruction. Our leadership team has implemented a phased set of goals to help drive annual improvements to culture and instruction. Finally, our school has set up an intensive coaching plan to provide each teacher in the building with an instructional coach to help support their professional growth.

 Three Oaks Public School Academy is a charter school with no attendance boundaries.
- 2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN



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The Three Oaks Public School Academy School Improvement Plan was developed through the disaggregation of data that focused on student achievement, facilities, and parent, staff and community concerns. The target for the plan was for students to exceed assessment scores on the M-STEP and the NWEA-MAP tests from the previous school year. The school improvement team monitored progress to maintain alignment with academic goals. M-STEP and NWEA MAP standardized tests in grades K-6 were analyzed to determine students' needs. Areas of emphasis were reading and math. The School Improvement Plan for 2023-2024 includes academic goals for the four core curricular areas and intense intervention for students below grade level. It is continuously reviewed and updated as needed to ensure that the students' needs are being met. The school leadership teams meet weekly to work towards goals related to academic growth, parent involvement, effective instruction, and creating a positive environment. 3. A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL

Three Oaks Public School Academy is an urban school located at 1212 Kingsley St. in Muskegon, MI. It is a school wide Title I school with 100% of students receiving free breakfast and lunch. It has been a school honored by the State of Michigan and other publications for beating the odds in regards to projected academic proficiency and growth. It operates using the Scholar Schools Model for academics which includes customized coaching for teachers and a positive behavior support plan with tiered response to intervention and various enrichment activities. The mission of Three Oaks Public School Academy is to create a community school of excellence that provides an opportunity for all Muskegon area children to be engaged and empowered learners.
